**PURCHASE OF FRESH CITRUS FOR

AND OTHER DOMESTIC FEEDING PROGRAMS**

A M E N D M E N T N O . 1

The purpose of this amendment is to change the inspection requirement as stated in paragraph IX. INSPECTION of Announcement FV-116 as follows:

- A. The fresh citrus shall be inspected, and certified, upon arrival at destination by the Federal or Federal-State Inspection Service in accordance with Article 54 and 55 of USDA-1. Inspection shall be done in accordance with the Destination Tolerances in the U.S. Grade Standards. The vendor shall be responsible for arranging and paying for inspection.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.

**PURCHASE ANNOUNCEMENT FOR FRESH CITRUS
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

The purpose of this amendment is to:

(1) Add exhibit A, and (2) Delete in the first sentence of Article XIV, "Certification of Product Origin" of Announcement FV-116, "a statement" and replace with, "the certification in Exhibit A".

(3) Add provision B under Section 1, General, and to include the Standard Form 129 in Section IV, Provisions of Contract.

Section 1, B, is added to read as follows:

B. Cancellation, Rescission, and Recovery of Funds for Illegal or Improper Activity

1. If the Government receives information that a contractor or person has engaged in conduct constituting a violation of subsection (a), (b), (c), or (d) of section 27 of the Office Federal Procurement Policy Act (41 U.S.C. 423) (the Act), as amended, the Government may --

- a. Cancel the solicitation, if the contract has not yet been awarded or issued; or
- b. Rescind the contract with respect to which --

(1) The Contractor or someone acting for the Contractor has been convicted for an offence where the conduct constitutes a violation of Subsection 27 (a) or (b) of the Act for the purpose of either --

(a) Exchanging the information covered by such subsections for Anything of value; or

(b) Obtaining or giving anyone a competitive advantage in the award of Federal agency procurement contract; or

(2) The head of the contracting activity has determined, based upon a preponderance of the evidence, that the Contractor or someone acting for the Contractor has engaged in conduct constituting an offense punishable under subsection (27) (e) (1) of the Act.


2. If the Government rescinds the contract under paragraph 91) of this clause, the Government is entitled to recover, in addition to any penalty prescribed by law, the amount expended under the contract.

3. The rights and remedies of the Government specified herein are not exclusive, and are in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law, regulation, or under this Announcement.

Additionally, Section IV, Provisions of Contract, page 4, is amended by adding the words "Standard Form 129" after "Contractor's offer," in the first line.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
